We can't wait to see the latest exhibition from rebel fashion photographer Juergen Teller at the Lehmann Maupin Gallery February 10. The gallery will feature the German-born artist's edgy commercial and private work in a three-part show that includes his provocative photographs of Kristen McMenamy, alongside frank portraits of the artist's family and friends.
